Praying the Rosary




The Sign of the Cross: In the name of the Father of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

The Apostles Creed: I believe in God the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord; Who was conceived by the Holy Ghost, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. On the third day He arose again; He ascended into heaven, is seated at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen

The Our Father: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name: Thy kingdom come: Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. The Mysteries of the Rosary

A Mystery is something very precious that you discover bit by bit and understand a little more each time.

The mysteries of the Rosary are important moments in Jesus' life that we think about together with Mary, to be able to understand them better.

When you pray the rosary, you are united with all other people near or far away who are praying to Mary at the same time as you.

Generally the mysteries are prayed as follows:

Mondays and Saturdays—Joyful mysteries

Thursdays - Luminous mysteries

Tuesdays and Fridays -Sorrowful mysteries

Wednesdays and Sundays –Glorious mysteries

To pray the rosary

- 1) Begin with the Sign of the Cross and the Apostles Creed
- Pray the Our Father
- Pray 3 Hail Marys
- 3) 4) 5) Pray the Glory Be to the Father
- Start the Mystery and set of 10 Beads by praying the Our Father then 10 Hail Marys. Do this 5 times until you work your way around to the end and finish with a Glory be to the Father (6-13)

- Glory Be to the Father: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.
- The Fatima Prayer: "O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, and lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Your Mercy". (Our Lady at Fatima, 13th July 1917)
- The Hail, Holy Oueen: Hail, holy Oueen, Mother of Mercy! our life, our sweetness, and our hope! To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve; to thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley, of tears. Turn, then, most gracious Advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us; and after this our exile show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus; O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Marv.


